Brian Williams

At Brian Williams' company... there has been a culture of slack timekeeping ... so employees have been arranging for others to clock them in and out and claiming for hours that they have not actually worked. Senior managers have been claiming to work from home for long hours.

There is a suspicion of tacit acceptance of young people, especially young women, below the legal age limit, who are drinking in a public bar.

Property is regularly taken: crockery, towels and bed linen have disappeared and office staff have taken stationery and computer equipment home. Left over food is being eaten by staff and some foods are being condemned so that they can be eaten at home despite being edible. Kitchen staff view this theft of food as a perk of their job. They claim that it makes up for the low wages they earn and the poor employment practices of senior managers.
